




HAMEAU DUBCEUF IN FIGURES


The Hameau Dubœuf opened its doors in 1993. This wine theme park revealed its origins and the secrets of its vineyards and winemaking techniques.


The Hameau Dubœuf offers:

- 2,000,000 visits since it's opening











The place that time forgot is a reconstruction of the hall of a railway station in the 1900s. The murals, painted by a Lyonnais artist, represent the well-known sites of the south of the Beaujolais region, the region of the yellow stone buildings, and right up to the Mâconnais region.





At Hameau Dubœuf, pleasure is also found in the food. 







THE MUSEOLOGY





The wine cellars are used for the ageing of wine in oak barrels, such as the 'Moulin à Vent' of the Beaujolais region and the 'Pouilly-Fuissé' of the Mâconnais region.





THE ROOM OF AMPELOGRAPHY





'Le Toine' is a winemaker from the Beaujolais region. He is a rather grumpy old man, but his grandson manages to persuade him to tell the visitors of Hameau Dubœuf about the history of his land. It is the beginning of an incredible immersive experience and is the newest attraction of Hameau Dubœuf. Sitting in Le Toine's wine-cellar, the visitor starts upon a magnificent voyage through time.



Thanks to its projections and special effects, visitors are taken on a journey through the ages. From the Roman invasion to the industrial revolution of the 19th Century, lasting 15 minutes, you will become actors in the beautiful history of the Beaujolais by learning about the often harsh lifestyles of viticulturists as well as the evolution of the climate and nature of the Beaujolais region.



This 3D film is based on the theme of the celebrations that take place at the end of the wine harvest, with famous personalities: Bernard Pivot, Christian Marian and famous chef Paul Bocuse.



Climb aboard the simulation pods and move along to the projections on the two giant screens. Visitors will be able to discover the beauty of the scenic Beaujolais and Mâconnais landscapes.



THE EXHIBITION HALL


The exhibition hall of advertising posters. These are originals, certain posters date back to the beginning of the 20th century.



The visit continues with artefacts and information of the wine trade: the wine making process, the making of wine barrels, the making of glass and the making of the corks

A sommelier will suggest and explain different wines of the Beaujolais and Mâconnais regions to our guests.



THE TRAIN STATION AND IMPERIAL TRAIN CARRIAGE




Hameau Duboeuf celebrates its **30 years** since their opening, and it will take place at the train station which is being completely renovated for the occasion. As of the 8th of april 2023 a brand new sound and light show **"l'Impérial**" is to be discovered by the visitors.



For the enjoyment of the old and the young, the little train of Hameau Dubœuf will take you from the wine museum to the vinification centre.



At the heart of the vineyards, the garden of Beaujolais allows visitors to discover the scents of flowers, fruits and spices that make up the rich aromas of wine. It is the perfect place for plant enthusiasts and families alike. Climb aboard our 'rosalies' and discover our gardens. For our younger visitors of 3+, we have 'sulky's' available.



The vinification centre of the wines of Georges Dubœuf puts visitors at the heart of viticulture and wine production. Here, the techniques of making wine are explained, where technology and a respect for old traditions come together in the wine barrels and the 150 stainless steel tanks.





ADVENTURE GOLF



All the way from Sweden, our Adventure Golf is miniature golf with a unique style: scenic, dynamic and integrated into the natural environment. Our adventure golf features each of the 10 holes as one of our 10 vintage wines of the Beaujolais. Whether you chose to play leisurely or more competitively, it is available for all ages older than 4 years old.



ACTIVITÉS TEAMBUILDING

• Enthronment « Confrérie du Beaujolais »:

Local traditions. Speech in the Beaujolais patois of the oath you have to take. Tasting of the « Tassée » in a wine taster. Delivery of the wine taster and visitor's book signature.

The aim of the brotherhood is to promote Beaujolais des Pierres dorées and brings together around thirty active members (mainly people from the world of wine)

Mixed brotherhood, their outfit illuminated by a golden yellow choker and an autumnal vine leaf, the Grapilleurs combine worship, Bacchus and folklore

Each applicant, after having taken an oath before Saint Vincent, patron saint of winegrowers, will receive: the golden stone cut in the shape of a vine leaf, the wine tasting with the arms of the brotherhood, the grapellers diploma of the Pierres Dorées

Duration: 45 minutes




